Allan Gill was a respected and honored businessman in the Powell community prior to his death. His career centered on utilities for the area and his position was General Manager of the Hallsdale Powell Utility District from 1954 until 1999.

Allan's civic and professional associations were many. He was a charter member and past president of the Powell Lions Club and a charter member of the Powell Business and Professional Association. The PBPA was a major contributor as the Powell High School Dreams Foundation was born. Allan Gill also was past president of PBPA. He was an honorary life member and past chair of the Tennessee Water and Wastewater Association, and lifetime member and past chair of the American Water Works Association. Other associations included the Kentucky-Tennessee Water Environment Federation, the national Rural Water Association, The Tennessee Water Quality Management Association, the Utilities Management Federation, Inc., and the Home Builders Association of Greater Knoxville. He also was a founding member of the Tennessee Association of Utility Districts and treasurer 1970-2002.

Allan received a variety of awards for his focus on our water systems and his business. These include the M. L. Brickey Award, TWWA, 1980, Powell Business Man of the Year, 1985, and induction into the Hall of Fame for Water and Wastewater Professionals from the Tennessee Water Quality Management Association in 1988.

Other honors include the George Warren Fuller Award from the American Water Works Association in 1988, the Chairman's Award of Appreciation for Service to TWWA in 1992, the Man of the Year Award from the Halls Business and Professional Club in 1992, the Powell Lions Club Merit Award and Health-Welfare Committee Chair in 1992. The Powell Lions Club also honored Allan with the Melvin Jones Fellowship Award. He became a member of the Quarter Century Operator's Club from the Water Environment Federation in 1992. In June of 2007, Allan Gill received the 50 Year Service Award from the Tennessee Association of Utility Districts.
