J. D. Jett's career in construction and development, athletics, and community service is a strong statement about his commitment to the Powell community. He has been active with the building of the Powell Sports Complex, the football, baseball, and softball fields, even bleachers and a concession stand. He also was involved in building the Powell Middle School soccer fields and the baseball fields at Powell Levi Ball Park.

His community service includes work as Assistant Scout Leader and Scout Master for 40 years with Troop 154, influencing many young scouts. Part of his work with scouts involved assisting the Powell High School football team along with his own team of scouts, helping along the sidelines.

Construction development also centers on building Weigel's convenience stores since 1984 and building of many of the homes in the Broadacres Subdivision.

J. D. also serves on the Heiskell Volunteer Fire Department, and as a member of Heiskell United Methodist Church for 45 years. He was named the 1983 PBMA Man of the Year.

Other awards include the Distinguished Service Award given by the East Tennessee Chapter National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame in 2009 for his contributions to amateur athletics.
