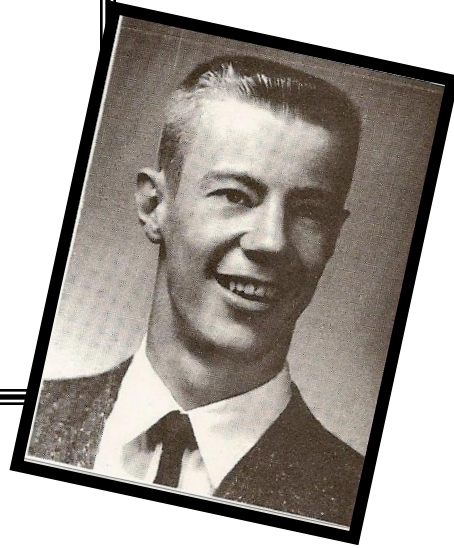

Tony Buhl , with a solid background from high school science, including physics and chemistry, focused on nuclear engineering and gained a Ph.D over time. As he matured in his chosen profession, his work ranged from nuclear safety to airplane wings to robots. He also served as a Captain in the US Army's nuclear defense and is a Service Disabled Veteran.

Tony was elected a Fellow of the American Nuclear Society, their highest honor. Tony also spent eight years in Washington, DC, as part of the Department of Energy and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. He received recognition for his efforts in the recovery of the Three Mile Island disaster in Pennsylvania, and also the one at Chernobyl in Russia. Tony Buhl also is proud to have established and managed four major high-tech companies dealing with his life's work. He has been successful in providing outstanding life contributions dealing with nuclear clean-up at Rocky Flats near Denver and now in Oak Ridge in Tennessee. Tony also helped engineer the establishment of the *Powell High School Dreams Foundation* and the first major project, the renovation of the staff work area, now named after him and in honor of the Class of 1959 PHS faculty and staff. A plaque honoring the teachers and other staff instrumental in starting him on his career now hangs in the staff work area.
